At Aatmaja Foundation we are committed to enabling bright young girls from disadvantaged backgrounds to become successful professionals.


- We will strive to be catalyst by helping young girls grow into confident, empowered professionals with strong values.



- Provided them with laptop and mobile as and when needed.
- Skill development program for Aatmajas in collaboration with Mastek-Developed Baseline skill for competency like leadership, perseverance, problem solving, decision making, creative thinking.
- Now we fully comply with national regulations to receive foreign donation under FCRA.
- Recruited 50 new Aatmajas, we reached out to them virtually due to closer of schools



- 3 engineering girls got job offer from a leading IT company.
- ➢ 6 BCom got job offer from a leading BPO company.
- 1 Aatmaja got selected for Global Robotic competition. She is attending online robotics training.
- In class 10 out of 46, 33 girls score above 80%
- In class 12 Science stream out of 12, 9 girls score above 70% and in commerce stream out of 11, 9 score above 70%.
