Our Programs

Udaan: Nurturing Dreams

We provide meritand need-based schlorship to girl students from disadvantaged backgrounds studying in 10th standard. Deserving girls are selected through a well-defined selection criteria and will be supported for 7-8 years until they become independent professionals. Every year we add 30 to 40 deserving girls to this programme.

Aasha Program: Creating livelihood and Self-sustenance for girls

We started this program in 2021 to Create livelihood and self-sustenance for girls by suggesting alternate career streams with an emphasis on skill development for better employability. It is a different segment of girls who need to be financially independent early and should be employable for a shorter duration after financial assistance. .

Revenue Officer 2019 - 2024

I began my journey at SSC & HSC from Mahatma Gandhi Vidyalaya Karmala. By scoring good marks in CET, I got admission to Mahatma Phule College of Agriculture, Pune. I come from an agricultural background, and my parents are farmers. Since my childhood, I have experienced difficulties faced by farmers. Hence, I decided to study agriculture. However, shifting to Pune was difficult for me as my parents could not afford the expenses. There is a saying "Where there is a will there is a way. I came to know about the Aatmaja foundation through my classmate who was also a beneficiary of the foundation. I approached them, underwent a selection process, and got selected for a scholarship in 2019. It benefited me immensely. Aatmaja Foundation not only took care of my education and other expenses but also helped me to develop my personality through various interventions and training programs. I Dhanashri Gaikwad will always be thankful to the foundation that played a vital role in my success. After Degree I appeared for Talati Exams, I got selected. Now I am working as Talati Officer in my taluka. I will do my best to help farmers and local villagers to be independent and educate their children.

Myself Sanskruti Sachin Narlawar. I have been studying Computer engineering at PCCOER, Ravet. When I was in first year, my father passed away while fighting with corona. He was working as art teacher at high school. My father was the only earning hand for our entire family and he was bearing all me and my younger brother's educational expenses. But due to this death, I was facing difficulties in paying further fees. His death has caused instability in our financial conditions and other aspects. I applied for my educational loan but it was rejected as my father was nominee. My family wasunable to afford all the educational expenditure, as my mother is a housewife and my father's pension was not sufficient. As my younger brother too has educational expenses with me. My mother has faced a lot of difficulties in managing all expenses in future. Then our college HOD Tushar Gaikwad sir referred me about scholarship by Aatmaja Foundation. I am grateful to be supported by Aatmaja Foundation. I was in my First year when I met Priya Ma'am. I was dealing with a lot of challenges, but the Sanskruti Naralwar Aatmaja team helped me to get over of this. Their support has not only helped me financially but also to become confident and career oriented. There are a lot of girls involved in the foundation, where we get to help each other. The Aatmaja team is incredibly kind, understanding, and helpful. I want to express my gratitude to Priti Ma'am and Priya Ma'am, who have always supported and encouraged me. I am thankful for making me part of this organization. Now I have been selected for an analyst role at Cappemini in campus placement. I will join after my final exams. 



Number of girls employed





1) How to crack Interviews/Industry expectations and CV writing by Vanderlande Industries team Mr. Milind Jadhav- Group Manager (HR)Mr. Abhijeet Nair - Talent Executive, Mr. Vinish Acharya - UX specialist

The session provided comprehensive interview preparation and insights into industry expectations, covering resume crafting, soft skills development, and real-world scenarios. Aatmajas discovered that preparation extends beyond interviews to the actual workplace, gaining knowledge on CV writing and the importance of practice and feedback to feel interview-ready.





2) Seeking Success in the Corporate Sector -Ms. Swati Ketkar a Women Entrepreneur.

Aatmajas learned some essential skills they need to develop in order to enter corporate sector. Aatmajas studying life science and other science courses got an opportunity to learn about careers and job opportunities in the IT sector through a training program conducted by Mr. Hrishikesh Dhande

4) Goal Setting and Coping with Emotions - Ms. Bhuvaneshwari Shurpali - A professional soft skill trainer and Mentor.

Aatmajas learned about open communication, emotional regulation, setting realistic goals, patience, and seeking professional help when needed. Equipping teenagers with these skills is essential for coping with everyday stress and fostering personal growth.

Girls were able to listen to the trends and tools applicable in the IT sector and also learned about the importance of AIDS, AIML & Cloud computing in the future.





Spoken English Class

One of the biggest challenges our Aatmajas face is with the English language. Most of them study in vernacular medium and find it difficult to converse in English confidently. To build their confidence in English as a medium, we have been arranging spoken English training for Our Aatmajas every year. This program runs for 6-8 weeks, each session is a combination of discussions, Vocabulary building, presentations, quizzes, and fun activity sessions among themselves under the guidance of a professional trainer, Mrs. Mallika Iyer. These sessions help them tremendously to be confident about themselves and help them converse better.





Company Visits

Visiting a corporate office is always a learning opportunity for our Aatmajas. Company visits helps Aatmajas bridge the gap between classroom learning and real-world application. We believe that first-hand experience in a corporate setting can significantly enhance our students' understanding of the concepts they learn in their academic programs.

1) eClerx Company visit -November 2023

Recruitment - Test & Interview

As soon as the mid-term exam of the schools is over, our selection process of students starts for next year's scholarship students. Aatmaja Foundation provides merit and need-based scholarships to female students from disadvantaged backgrounds. Deserving girls are selected through well-defined selection criteria and are supported until they become financially independent professionals. We look forward to meeting young and enthusiastic female students as part of this process.





Career Counseling & Aim Test

Every year, our Aatmajas from 10th grade go through a career counseling test, AIM (Aptitude & Intelligence Measurement Teat) developed by Jnana Prabhodini, Pune. This is a well-known method for measuring students' abilities & Career orientation. The test also provides insight into the individual's inclination toward possible career choices. A Guidance session then is conducted by our trained counsellor Priya Gurav which helps the girls choose the most suitable career stream for their higher education.





Induction Program & Certificate Distribution

Aatmaja Foundation organizes every year an induction program for students and parents to introduce them to the organization's objectives, values, and initiatives. The attendees participate in interactive sessions and presentations to gain knowledge about our organization's various initiatives, including education. The selected girls are awarded certificates and badges who have been granted scholarships. This gesture also reinforces the organization's commitment to supporting the educational aspirations of young girls, empowering them to pursue their dreams and create a brighter future for themselves and their communities.













Laptop/Springboard tab distribution

Corporate Social Responsibility plays a vital role in supporting communities and fostering education.
